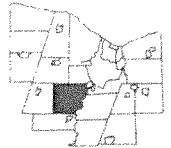

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM

Meeting Minutes for December 29, 2009 were presented, reviewed and approved.

Applicant Presentations:

The Father's House, 692 Paul Rd Rochester, NY 14624 to construct a 30' x 60' pole barn to be utilized as a utility shed on the property located at the aforementioned address. Building to be located approximately 660 feet from Paul Rd and 600 feet from Archer Road and 125 feet from the main structure on the property. This was a review on recommendations from December 2009 meeting

1. Use colors scheme that mimics the main structure on the property. At the least a color similar in shade and hue. Roof should be Weatheredge, color; tan 022.45TSR. Siding shall be Weatheredge, color; ivory-020-.60TSR
2. Use corner trim at all corners and around windows and doors. Color to match siding
3. All identifying monikers for colors, accessories or architectural attributes shall be submitted, approved and on file with the Board, committees and Building Department.
4. All doors and windows to match siding color

NORTH ELEVATION:

A- Implement landscaping, earth berm or a combination of both so as to shield any view of building from Paul Rd. Landscaping per the direction/ suggestions of the of the Conservation Board.

EAST ELEVATION:

1. Door and window height to match.

SOUTH ELEVATION:

1. Relocate overhead door form east side. Placement at the applicants discretion. Add windows to upper panels of door.
