Town of Chili Conservation Board - Approved Minutes January 4, 2016

The Chili Conservation Board meeting was called to order at 7:02 p.m. on January 4, 2016 at the Chili Town Hall, 3333 Chili Ave., Rochester, New York 14624.

Old Business:

New Hope Community Church – The Conservation Board recommends that New Hope be allowed to eliminate two trees from the original thirteen trees in the proposed landscape plan. The two trees will be replaced with a landscape effort (shrubby) along the Eastern wall. Since the scope of the project has changed, a motion was made that the Planning Board waive the necessity of a LLA stamped print. The motion was approved by the CB with a vote of five to one, with R.J. Schickler voting no.

Anchor Christian Church – The Conservation Board recommends that the expanse of asphalt parking lot, in front of the church building, be softened with a line of shrubs along the North edge. The CB unanimously agreed to let Chair, Larry Lazenby, review the resubmitted plans and stamp them approved.

New Business: Larry Lazenby accepted the appointment as the new Chairman of the Conservation Board. The CB members congratulate Larry and look forward to working with him. Thank you to Pat Tindale for her dedicated years as our former Chairperson!
