Summary of Approved Minutes
Town of Chili Drainage Committee

October 7, 2014

Matthew Sinacola, Chairperson called the meeting to order at 7:04 p.m.

The meeting was held at the Town Highway Garage Facility at 200 Beaver Rd.

MEMBERS PRESENT:

MEMBERS ABSENT:

MINUTES:

The September 2014 Meeting minutes were reviewed and approved without corrections.

GUESTS:

Joanne Rodrigues, 28 Madera Dr. and **Brad Heye, 475 Morgan Rd.:** Mr. Heye and Ms. Rodrigues came to discuss the ongoing problem with water accumulating on Ms. Rodrigues driveway at 28 Madera Dr. Brian indicated that he was familiar with the problem from previous discussions with Ms. Rodrigues. The pooling occurs at the end of the driveway, where an old stream bed was located many years ago. Brian suggested that he take another look at the site,

before any recommendations are made. Mr. Heye suggested that one option would be to lower the catch basin at the end of the drive way, Brian also suggested that a culvert might be an option to consider as well. Brian will visit the site in the coming weeks, and report back to the committee on his findings.

OLD BUSINESS and WORK COMPLETED:

The committee discussed the progress that had been made on the Drainage Committee Manual. Matt indicated that David was reviewing the most recent draft of the Manual, and would be following up with him in the coming weeks. Matt asked the committee members to review the most recent draft and be prepared to discuss any concerns at the November meeting. Brian reminded the committee that the DPW was presently going through an Audit, and as such, there may be some delays in following up some of the old business.

Matt and Tracy briefly discussed the need to review next year's meeting calendar. It was suggested by everyone that 10 meetings a year might be a workable schedule. Matt pointed out that if the agenda does not have many items for discussion, or if no guests are planning to attend, we can certainly forgo that month's meeting. The January and July meetings were tentatively set as months when no meeting will be held.

NEW BUSINESS:

The DPW has completed the clearing and removal of debris and underbrush in Wickins Ditch.

Fall Cleanup of Leaves and yard refuse has begun.

Tracy mentioned that the Town had recently received a state grant to build a Spray Park at Union Station Park.

MEMBER STATUS REVIEW:

Geoffrey Wiater has accepted the position of Vice Chairperson of the Chili Drainage Committee (3 year term). Dr. William Dingus has agreed to continue on as the Secretary of the Chili Drainage Committee. (3 year term).

REVIEW:

Master Halco outside Storage, 465 Paul Rd.: No drainage concerns

Bank of America ATM Kiosk: No drainage concerns

Anchor Christian Church (Education wing): No further drainage concerns, the Town Planning Board will review the plans once they have been submitted.

44 Jetview Drive LLC (Warehouse Expansion): Design plans appear to address all drainage on site. New and expanded storm water control features have been proposed, they include an enlarged retention pond, a rain garden, and a storm water distribution plan in the event that runoff exceeds normal levels.

Open Door Baptist Church, 350 Chili-Scottsville Rd. (Building Addition and Pavilion): No drainage concerns
