Scott Alexander introduced Geoffrey Wiater our newest member of the Drainage Committee. He
also introduced Matthew Sinacola, a citizen of Chili, who the Town Board is considering for a
position on the Drainage Committee. The committee welcomed the new and potential future
members to the meeting.

Minutes from the October 2011 Meeting were approved

OLD BUSINESS and WORK COMPLETED:

3 Oak Twist Circle: Brian asked if the Town had any regulations regarding the installation of concrete gutters in shallow swales. He will discuss several options with the homeowner this month.

22 Rio Grande Dr.: After consulting with Grey, Brian decided not to do any work. The Town will however assist the homeowner with a tie-in to the existing yard inlet, in the event they decide to install a yard drain on the property.

932 Paul Rd.: Completed. Brian indicated that the Town crews have cleaned out the ditch that runs in the back of the property several years ago. He suggested that it may need to be cleaned again in the spring of 2012.

310 Chestnut Ridge Rd.: Work Completed

6, 8, 10, 12 Cutter Dr.: Work Completed

14, 16, 18, 22, 24, Wills Rd.: Brian feels that one good option may be to lay drainage pipe across the back yard, and connect to the existing drain (Town easement) between 12-14 Wills Rd. Brian will talk with Grey to determine the best strategy. The Town is not sure if this project is going to go forward at this time. The person leading the project request has sold their home, so this may put it on hold for now. If other property owners request action on this project, the Town will revisit it at that time.

15 and 17 Creek view: Work completed

9, 11, 13 Matlyn Dr.: Work is almost completed. Brian indicated that the Town plans to add more top soil before the winter sets in.

Park Place including 18 Tyndale Way: Work Completed

52 Wilellen: Brian spoke with David about what options the Town should consider. The Town has no plans of doing anything at the site. The Town has communicated this to the homeowner. Cleaning out the crook will not solve the problem, because the problem is caused by a seasonal increase (high water) in the water table.

50 Brook view: Work Completed.
