OLD BUSINESS and WORK COMPLETED:

- Leaf Pick up during Oct. and Nov. went very well. 8000 yards of leaves in a typical year.
- Very little snow removal this Nov. 2009.
- Work at **14 James Hollow Drive** starting.
- Maintenance work to remove leaves clogging up many catch basins throughout the town.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Work at **14 James Hollow Drive** regrading has started.
- Work at **Bright Oaks** is continuing.
- Work at **King Rd.** (Mr. Nasso) will be running a pipe to tie into his drainage work.
- Work at **Black Cedar Dr.** will be completed by the developer in the spring. He is still building homes.
- Work at **4 Rochelle** will be reviewed. Rear yard drainage problem. Issue with timeline for holding developer responsible for grading and seeding swale.
- Work at **Kagler Dr.** Eastside of Road has 200' drainage channel with grass growing in it. Property has an easement.

REVIEW:

- 1 Update on 2030 Comprehensive Plan Committee.
- 2 Microtel Developers have taken care of issues. Structure reduced from 3 stories to 2 stories. Drainage issues have been resolved.
- 3 Mid lakes Development Site between Fathers House and Wegman's; preliminary plans were reviewed.
There was some discussion about Retention Ponds, and drainage problems inherent to this building site.
4 retention Ponds will be on site. Town will acquire an easement to access ponds.
