Summary of Approved Minutes

April 6, 2010

MINUTES:

Minutes from the March 2010 Meeting were approved

GUESTS:

No guest were present

OLD BUSINESS and WORK COMPLETED:

24 Wills Rd. Problem with standing water in the backyard. David reviewed and discussed the problems in the back yard of the home. He will check to see if the town has an easement. If so, then will help with providing an extension to the existing catch basin that is 3 lots over. The owner has given the town permission to walk the lot to access possible solutions for the problem.

David Lindsay again suggested that all members consider attending training seminars that are available. Members can sign up on line. Some of the topics include site plans, water and wetland issues, and concepts in managing storm water runoff problems.

NEW BUSINESS:

Work at **Black Creek** removed a large tree that had fallen across the creek; just off of Stottle Rd.

Work at **Hillary Rd.** another large tree fell across a pedestrian bridge. Tree was removed. Owner of property will need to make minor repairs to bridge structure.

Work at **Expressway ramp of 490** near Chili- Coldwater Rd. Ditch was cleaned out to improve drainage along the backyards of several homes adjoining the ramp to 490.

Work at **Ronald Pickett's** home. Problem with neighboring sump pump discharge into his backyard. Cut pipe and diverted discharge into adjoining catch basin.

Work on servicing equipment and routine springtime maintenance

REVIEW:

- 1 Update on 2030 Comprehensive Plan Committee. Dr. Dingus discussed the Committee's review of Chapter 4 of the Plan with a short discussion of the objectives and goals.
- 2 The planned Teen Center off of Scottsville Rd. has been pulled off the Planning Board Agenda.
- 3 Mid lakes Development Site between Fathers House and Wegman's; the most recent revised plans were reviewed. There was some additional discussion about Retention Ponds, and drainage problems inherent to this building site.
