Summary of Approved Minutes
Town of Chili Drainage Committee

April 7, 2015

Geoffrey Wiater, Vice Chairperson called the meeting to order at 7:04 p.m.

The meeting was held at the Town Highway Garage Facility at 200 Beaver Rd.

MEMBERS ABSENT:

MINUTES:

The February 2015 Meeting minutes were approved without corrections.

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GUESTS:

No Guest were present

OLD BUSINESS and WORK COMPLETED:

Everyone thanked Brian for the crews dedicated work in keeping the Town streets and highways clear throughout this “lengthy” winter season.

Tracy informed the committee that Town Supervisor and Town Council had reviewed Drainage Committee Manual, and had approved it for future use by the Committee. Tracy also recommended that the committee members take the time to go to the Town website and review the Drainage Committee duties and responsibilities, to see if any changes need to be made based on the newly approved Drainage Committee Manual.

NEW BUSINESS:

Brian discussed a few of the waterline breaks that the Monroe County has had to address. Of note, was the one on **Ranchmar sub-division**, where a Contractor removed a catch basin and section of pipe, in order to repair a water main break. The MCWA (Monroe County Water Authority) will be repairing the storm sewer and putting everything back together.

50 Middleborough Dr.: Homeowner wanted to install yard inlets and trench drains to improve a drainage problem in his yard. Brian indicated that there was an existing yard catch basin in the adjacent property to the north that he could tie into. The DPW would help facilitate this, by providing a connection to the catch basin.

MEMBER STATUS REVIEW:

The Town Council has asked the Committee to reach out to anyone who resides in the Town and who may wish to volunteer as a member of the Drainage Committee. This will enable us to fill the fifth (5) position on the committee that is yet unfilled.

REVIEW:

Vista Villa's Archer Rd.: The Planning Board has approved the initial Phases of the Residential housing project. Matt indicated that there were no drainage issues that required the committees input.

Buckingham Properties, 100 Archer Matt indicated that presently, there are no drainage issues that require the Committee's input.

Town Council: Has passed a number of ordinances dealing with Architectural review of Building projects and Storage facilities on large parcels of land. Tracy indicated that details on these new ordinances can be seen on the Town website.

Union Station: Matt suggested that members try to stop by the site to take a look at how the developer was handling the temporary drainage issues that are part of any Construction project.
