MINUTES:

Minutes from the April 2011 Meeting were approved

GUESTS:

Alan VanDemeere: 52 Wilelen Rd. Homeowner has lived there for approximately 30 years. He finds that the problem most severe after heavy rains. He has had as much as 1 ft. of water in his basement, even thou the distance from the storm drain is approximately 400 ft. His sump pump runs constantly. Backyard storm drain is not working. Homeowner feels that the situation is exsaserbated by the fact that the soil is very sandy. Brian not certain that the catch basin is at fault, my infact be a high water table. The committee members along with Brian will arrange a time to visit the site between now and the next meeting.

Richard and Alan Miller: 6 Cutter Dr. Homeowner has lived at this location for 40 years. **Don Brown: 12 Cutter Dr. :** Homeowner has lived at this location for 25 years. **Don Allen: 14 Cutter Dr.** Homeowner has lived at this location for 25 years. Backyards sloops down toward 14 Cutter Dr. Drainage from Harmony empties into the back of Cutter Dr. There is a blockage in the exisiting drain between 6 and 12 Cutter Dr. Brian will arrange a sight visit prior to the next meeting. He feels that the problem may be solved by converting the exisiting 6" pipe to 12" and also converting the exisiting 4" pipe to 6". Scott asked members to arrange some time to visit the site prior to the next meeting.

Richard Hoff: 50 Brookview Located on the west side of the street, the homeowner has been lived there for 9 years. There is standing water at two corners of the backyard, approximately 10' from the patio. Brian is aware of the problem, and will arrange some time to get a crew out to the sight as soon as we have some consistent dry weather.

OLD BUSINESS and WORK COMPLETED:

General Spring Clean up: Removing leaves and yard debris that was left due to the winter snow, clearing culverts, ditches and storm drains.

Scott & Laura Salvia: 13 Matlyn Dr. The committee members along with Brian visited the site. Have not received Blue prints for the addition to the home. Brian feels that we may be able to get to the work by late summer.

Greg and Mary Rowe: 11 Matlyn Dr. Part of the ongoing issue with drainage on Matlyn Dr. Brian and his crews will be addressing the issue of water flow across the backyards between 9,11 and 13 Matlyn Dr.

Rick Dambrosia: 9 Matlyn Dr. Part of the ongoing issue with drainage on Matlyn Dr.

Brendan Quinn: 38 Blue Ridge Trail Brian, David Lindsay, and Grey have researched this problem, and have concluded that they will need cooperation from the homeowner at **40 Blue Ridge Trail** in order to solve the problem.

NEW BUSINESS:

40 Lexington Parkway: Homeowner reports standing water in his backyard. Brian took a look at the site and will be making recommendations after discussing the problem with Grey.

REVIEW:

Genesee Valley Regional Market: The committee reviewed Revised Plans for a 70,000 sq. ft warehouse Facility off of West River Rd. (Scottsville Rd). Retention Ponds north and south of the facility were discussed.
