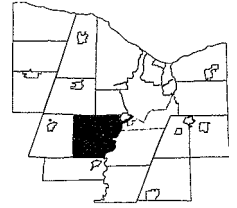

Minutes of the 6/5/08 Meeting

Meeting called to order by Chairman Fred Trott at 7:00P.M.
Minutes of the May meeting were approved.

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OLD BUSINESS 7/6/06

Item # 4 Traffic is backing up on Rt. 259 past Rt. 490 exit from Chili Ave., reported by committee members the problem continues, mini gridlocks. Churchville Chili School bus was hit by a car passing on the right shoulder at the intersection of Rt. 259 and Chili Ave. The intersection continues to be a hazard. What is the schedule for the permanent fix to the problem? State to widen road for 2 lanes for southbound traffic, one lane for turns (no signal upgrade). M. Sperr will get together with Senator Alesi and ask for additional state funding for improvements. Work to start sometime in 2010. M. Sperr and D. Lindsay have scheduled a meeting with Kevin O'Buckley from NYSDOT.

OLD BUSINESS 10/4/07

Item # 2 Barb Denigris of 254 Archer Rd representing the residents are concerned about safety as current speeds are in excess of the 30mph. Committee will continue to monitor, and the towns temporary signs will be set up in the spring. Compliant come in from 248 Archer also. The Monroe County Sheriff is monitoring.

OLD BUSINESS 12/6/07

- Item # 2 **Mr.** Cheng-Ning Jong of 92 Parkway Dr. has again requested help with the problem of cars not negotiating the curve in front of his house. The last car ended up on its side resting up against Mr. Jong's house.
J. Carr has moved the "curve sign". The committee has suggested the following: installing a "stop sign at the intersection of Parkway Dr. and Gilead Hill Rd., installing hedges on the front lawn to stop vehicles, and inverted rumble strips. **G.** Bartnett conducted a traffic study, no issues with people stopping or not stopping at the new stop sign.

OLD BUSINESS 1/3/08

- Item # 3 making a right turn from Chili Coldwater Rd. onto Rt. 490 E.; many cars are not making the turn and sliding off into the ditch. Dave Lindsey to follow up with **Mr.** O'Buckley at NYSDOT.

OLD BUSINESS 2/7/08

- Item # 2 Committee reviewed plans for a 66 room motel by Microtel behind Valvoline and the Bank of Castile on Chili Ave. The committee had some concerns:
- a – size of road width and radius of curve
 - b – traffic around building, road needs to be 26 feet wide.
 - c – fire access on plan with front parking only
 - d – committee would like to see a traffic study on the need for traffic light at the intersection of Old Scottsville Road and Chili Ave. At the last study that was done, it was a failing intersection.
- Committee reviewed updated plans; still have concerns about enough room for Fire truck to make it all the way around building.
- Item # 3 Railroad tracks on Paul Rd. near Beahan Rd. are very rough. To repaired this summer.

OLD BUSINESS 5/1/08

- Item# 1 The Fathers House has requested a meeting with D. Lindsay and the Sheriffs Department about what they may do for traffic control for Sunday services. Guest Steve Ginovsky Jr. reported that on two separate occasions he was stopped on Paul Rd. by the crossing guard from the Fathers House when no one was coming out of the Fathers House's parking lot. **No meeting was held. The church has no one in the street directing traffic now. The Sheriff to monitor.**
- Item # 4 Committee received a complaint that people are speeding on Rio Grand Dr. near Trestle Tr. **D. Lindsay to install "Slow Down" signs on the post for speed limits signs.**
- Item # 5 Committee received a complaint that the lighting on Westside Dr. at Roberts Wesleyan College crosswalk in not adequate. **D. Lindsay will contact the school and Town of Ogden.**

NEW BUSINESS 6/5/08

- Item # 1 Steve Kramer reported parking issues on Names Rd., Charles Rd. and Alfred Rd.
- Item # 2 M. Sperr reported the concern for sidewalks on Union Rd. from Chili Ave. to Black Creek Park. There has been an increase in pedestrian traffic on the shoulder of Union Rd. of families walking to and from Byrne Dairy and other stores and activities. **Committee recommends the investigation of the need for sidewalks.**
- Item # 3 The committee reviewed plans for Wegmans to add a **400,000** sq. ft. building at Wegmans Market St. **Committee had no issues.**
