Planning Board Report:

Planning Board liaison, and Chair, Pat Tindale, reported that a special Planning Board meeting had been called for the 1350 S RLLC project.

- The applicant incorporated the changes and suggestions recommended by the Conservation Board at their June 4th, 2012 meeting.

The LLA prints were stamped approved July 3, 2012. They included the CB recommendations that a quality grass seed containing Kentucky bluegrass and fescue be planted and the Austrian Pines to be replaced with Fraser Fir.

Old Business:

- The Greenwood Townhouses LLA prints were stamped approved on July 2, 2012.
- The completed Conservation Board Checklist was received from Home Team Sports Complex, 420 Ballantyne Road- the plans were stamped approved with an addition that a two year guarantee be placed on the plantings.

New Business:

- The Conservation Board received notice that a check for \$3,095.34 was received from Amchar Wholesale (in lieu of actual landscaping) - therefore the check should be deposited in the Town of Chili Tree Fund.
- Dorothy Borgus voiced her concern about the Perna property located at the corner of Chili Ave. and Union Street.
