Minutes: The July 6, 2009 CB minutes were approved with a change in tree size.

Planning Board Report: Patrick Evans from Tiffany Transportation contacted the Chair for advice on the plantings that should be grown on his property. Dick Schickler will contact him.

- There was no Planning Board agenda this month.

For Discussion: Pat Tindale and Dick Schickler walked the property at 741 Paul Road now owned by Mid-Lakes Development. They were disappointed that bark was stripped from some large trees that will probably eventually die due to this injury. The Red-tailed Hawk lost its habitat and numerous toads were flattened. They recommended fencing around the trees to be preserved and along the wetlands for protection

- Aramark Corp. is not maintaining its recently planted landscaping.
- Board members took on more projects for the Adopt-A-Project
- There was discussion on the proposed Microtel Hotel which will be back before the Planning Board soon. Dick and Pat will re-examine the landscape plantings before the next CB meeting to see if and where improvements are needed.

Budget: The 2010 Conservation Board budget to be submitted will remain the same as the 2009 budget. Pat Tindale will contact the Town and request that unspent monies be placed in the designated Reserve Fund.
