Approved Minutes FROM THE ARCHITECTURAL ADVISORY COMMITTEE MEETING OF August 28th, 2013

August 28th, 2013

To: Architectural Advisory Committee.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by Chairman Ignatowski. All members were present.

The Chairman introduced the members.

New Business

1. Review of proposed Science and Nursing building for Robers Wesley College located at 2301 Westside Drive, Rochester, NY. Michael Presentation was made by Mark Maddalina from SWBR Architects.

Mr Maddalina described the proposal noting that the building was to be attached to the existing Smith Science center building. The materials and colors were described and samples submitted for review.

Committee member comments:

Robert Latragna asked why the building was not designed to conform to the existing architecture on campus. Also noted were the requirement that some of the materials that were not yet decided upon would need to be submitted before a determination could be made on approval. These materials are the glass color, signage and lighting. Member Mark Merry also requested specifications on the fasteners being used to affix the metal panels. Matt Emens questioned the brick size as it was not the same size as the brick used for other structures on campus. Approval of the new brick size was given by all members. Chairman Ignatowski commented that the building architecture showed a lack of cohesion with as many as five separate materials. Matt Emens asked about the reflectivity of the metal sheathing and its effect on traffic on Buffalo Road. Mr Devito commented that the project appeared dark in color and also questioned the durability of the courtyard pavers. Approval was tabled until after receipt of the requested materials.

2. Review of revised monument sign for American Tire Distributors located at 2709 Chili Avenue

There was no presenter and the committee discussed the sign application. Comments included the need for the sign, colors of the sign, size of the sign and placement of the sign.

The committee gave approval for the sign with the condition that the background color of the sign be changed to match the earth tone color of the ATD building.

Old Business

The minutes from the June 26th, 2013 AAC meeting were approved unanimously.
