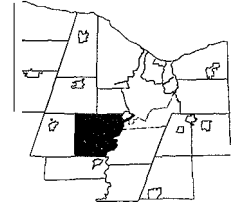

OLD BUSINESS 7/6/06

Item # 4 Traffic is backing up on Rt. 259 past Rt. 490 exit from Chili Ave., reported by committee members the problem continues, mini gridlocks. Churchville Chili School bus was hit by a car passing on the right shoulder at the intersection of Rt. 259 and Chili Ave. The intersection continues to be a hazard. What is the schedule for the permanent fix to the problem? State to widen road for 2 lanes for southbound traffic, one lane for turns (no signal upgrade). M. Sperr will get together with Senator Alesi and ask for additional state funding for improvements. Work to start sometime in 2010. M. Sperr and D. Lindsay have scheduled a meeting with Kevin O'Buckley from NYSDOT.

OLDBI SINESS 10 4/07

Item # 2 Barb Denigris of 254 Archer Rd representing the residents are concerned about safety as current speeds are in excess of the 30mph. Committee will continue to monitor, and the towns' temporary signs were used. The Monroe County Sheriff is monitoring. F. Trott will send an email to Monroe County Sheriff Lt. Clar.

OLD BUSINESS 1/3/08

- Item # 3 Making a right turn from Chili Coldwater Rd. onto Rt. 490 E.; many cars are not making the turn and sliding off into the ditch. Dave Lindsey to follow up with Mr. O'Buckley at NYSDOT.

OLD BUSINESS 2/7/08

- Item # 2 Committee reviewed plans for a 66 room motel by Microtel behind Valvoline and the Bank of Castile on Chili Ave. The committee had some concerns:
- a – size of road width and radius of curve
 - b – Traffic around building, road needs to be 26 feet wide.
 - c – fire access on plan with front parking only
 - d – Committee would like to see a traffic study on the need for traffic light at The intersection of Old Scottsville Road and Chili Ave. At the last study that was done, it was a failing intersection.

Committee reviewed updated plans and is satisfied with the new changes.

- Item # 3 Railroad tracks on Paul Rd. near Beahan Rd. are very rough. **To repaired this summer.**

OLD BUSINESS 5/1/08

- Item # 4 Committee received a complaint that people are speeding on Rio Grand Dr. near Trestle Tr. D. Lindsay has installed "Slow Down" signs on the post for speed limits signs.
- Item # 5 Committee received a complaint that the lighting on Westside Dr. at Roberts Wesleyan College crosswalk is not adequate. **MCDOT Brent Penwarden has spoken with the school about the lighting and the intersection meets all codes. The lighting is adequate.**

OLD BUSINESS 6/5/08

- Item # 2 M. Sperr reported the concern for sidewalks on Union Rd. from Chili Ave. to Black Creek **Park**. There has been an increase in pedestrian traffic on the shoulder of Union Rd. of families walking to and from Byrne Dairy and other stores and activities. F. Trott sent letter of request of the need for sidewalks. **Chili did not win the grant but will peruse next time.**

OLD BUSINESS 8/7/08

- Item# 1 The guests representing Union Station and Rio Grand expressed concerns of speeding on both roads for more speed limit signs . They also requested a 3 way stop sign at the intersection in Union Station. A speed study was conducted for **5** days, **1,100** vehicles were recorded in the study. Only **25** vehicles were over the posted limit of **30** MPH, range of speed 31 to 39.
- Item # 2 Request for a "Children at Play" sign in the Hightree and Crossbow area. Committee will investigate. **D.** Lindsay will put up temporary sign "**neighborhood** slow down".
- Item # 3 Request for speed bumps on Evergreen. F. Trott to send an email to Monroe County Sheriff Lt. Clar.
- Item # 4 Request for Paul Rd to be a solid double line on the entire section from Archer Rd. to Chili Ave. MCDOT Brent Penwarden will look at the possibility of a solid double line.
- FYI** At the intersection of Morgan Rd and Union St. the bushes are growing out to the road. The bushes need to be trimmed. **D.** Lindsay to contact the people about trimming the bushes.

NEW-BUSINESS 9/4/08

- Item # 1 Crosswalk over the railroad tracks on Old Scottsvilleroad are ~~warn~~ off.
- Item # 2 John Panes of 12 Tarrytown Dr. has requested "Children at Play" sign. Committee will investigate.
- Item # 3 Mercedes Dr. is being used as a cut thru and **traffic** is speeding. **D.** Lindsay To put up **s** temporary sign.

No further business discussed. Meeting adjourned at 8:20 PM
