Summary of Approved Minutes

Matt Sinacola, Chairperson called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

The August 4, 2015 Meeting minutes were approved

GUESTS:

OLD BUSINESS and WORK COMPLETED:

#320 Paul Road

Brian indicated to the committee that he had discussed the need to enlist the support of the adjoining neighbors with Joy Gartland and Monique Harding. He reiterated that the solution to the drainage issues would require support from their neighbors due to the lack of an easement across many of the properties that border 320 Paul Rd.

#17 Wills Road; #4 Rose Road; #7 Deb Ellen Drive (no guests)

Brian discussed the results of his study of the area. He felt that the most beneficial thing that could be done would be to build a manhole and improve the grade of the swale in order to eliminate the settling of water, during a rain event. He further indicated that the Town would need to make the manhole deep enough to accommodate the use of a sump pump. Deb Ellen Dr. culvert on the (Northside) and yard inlet on the (Southside), should adequately address the issues in that location.

#31 Talos Way (no guests)

Brian reiterated that during his inspection, he could not find any evidence that the ditch was not functioning properly. There is some wood debris present along the route of the ditch, but it is not impeding the flow in any significant way. Brian contacted the owner.

NEW BUSINESS:

28 Madera Dr.: The homeowner had asked the Town to investigate a problem with water flowing over the driveway and into a catch basin. Brian indicated that the project is on DPW's list of projects to address, and that it would be completed in the fall or early next year, weather permitting.

50 Bright Oaks: Brian will reach out to the homeowner to advise them of past work that was completed on the ditch which runs behind the homes. Members may reference minutes from Drainage Committee meeting for August and September 2012.
