320 Paul Rd.: Brian spoke with Joy Gartland regarding the sediment issue next to her niece's fence. He indicated that the Town could not do anything about the problem, since it appeared to be an issue related to the fence and not the grading or drainage. Brian did indicate that the DPW will periodically look at the site, to see if conditions have changed.

3774 Union St.: Brian spoke with Louis Gracy the homeowner regarding the drainage issue behind his house. He informed Mr. Gracy that as weather permitted, the DPW would be running pipe and installing several yard catch basins to help alleviate the standing water problem.

Drainage Committee Manual: The committee had a lengthy discussion about additional comments brought up by Commissioner David Lindsay from the last meeting. Matt suggested that we include several maps that identified key areas prone to flooding, he also pointed out the need to cross reference definitions in our Handbook with the Town Comprehensive Plan (2030). Other topics discussed, included adding language regarding soil types and ponds. The consensus of the Committee was that a simple, straight forward and readable Drainage Committee Handbook is the ultimate goal.
