## **Town of Chili Drainage Committee**

**Sept 7, 2010**

Scott Alexander, Vice Chairperson called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

**MEMBERS PRESENT:**

James Gamble, Scott Alexander, Brandon Tumia, David May, Dr. William Dingus, David Lindsay Commissioner of Public Works/Superintendent of Highways, Brian Ostling Deputy Commissioner of Public Works, and Hon. Tracy DiFlorio, Councilwoman

**MINUTES:**

Minutes from the August 2010 Meeting were approved

**GUESTS:**

No guest were present

**OLD BUSINESS and WORK COMPLETED:**

**Chestnut Ridge and Chili Ave.;** Shallow Retention Pond escavated to a depth of 4 ‘

**Behan Rd. (Little Black Creek):** Stabilized Bank along the creek

**Middleborough Dr. and Tyndale Way (Park Place):** Repaired Drainage Problem in Rear yard.

**3 Kings Way:** Yard inlet installed next to property to correct water runoff problem.

**206 Knights Trail:** Sent letter to adjoining home owner at 204 Knights Trail. Improper yard grading was affecting yard of 206 Knights Trail.

**12 James Hollow:** Minor regrading was completed on rear yard swale. The committee discussed the previously completed regrading of rear yard swale at 14 James Hollow. Members expressed concern that additional grading problems may surface farther up James Hollow.

**Laredo Rd.:** Regular Cleanup of Debris which accumulates in Ditch between the school and Road.

**James Hollow:** On going work from ground settlement. (Top soil was added and graded for drainage purposes)

### NEW BUSINESS:

**40 West Ham:** Brian, David and other Committee members looked at the problem in the rear yard catch Basin on North side of property. Town informed homeowner that if he installed a yard drain, town would connect it to the town storm drain system. The Town will advise homeowner on best method and location for rear yard drain.

**Brian Dr.:** Pond forming in Back yard and water accumulating in Basement. Homeowner is working on problem. Town will assist homeowner with back yard inlet.

**Kuebler Rd.:** Rear yard swale is not in the easement. Property has very little slope to runoff. Town needs a release to do any work. The Park on the other side of Keubler Rd is factor in this problem.

**Drainage District Expansion:** The committee discussed the future expansion of the Town of Chili Drainage District. This expansion will incorporate all property owners in the Town. This is a New York State mandated expansion, and will go into effect in the coming month.

### REVIEW:

Metalico Inc. reviewed plans for metal shredder.

Rezoning for the property on the southeast side of the intersection of Union St. and Chili Ave. (Neighborhood Business)
