**FROM THE ARCHITECTURAL ADVISORY COMMITTEE
MEETING OF NOVEMBER 26th 2014**

November 26th 2014

To: Architectural Advisory Committee.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by Chairman Ignatowski. The Chair introduced the members. Michael Divito, Matt Emens and Robert Latragna were present. The chairman declared that a quorum was reached

Old Business

1. A modified design for the Mavis Tire center located at 3209 Chili Avenue, Chili, NY 14624 was presented by Al Arilotta of ALA Architects.
Mr. Ignatowski questioned details of the design including the lighting above the door and that there would be no outside storage of tires. He also required that any enclosure for the dumpster would match the finish of the building. Mr. Emens suggested that gooseneck lighting be used for the sign, and confirmed that the garage doors were of glass construction. Mr. Ignatowski informed Mr. Arilotta that it would not be necessary to push the windows through the water table and that if the back lighted sign was not approved by zoning, soffit lighting would be acceptable.
2. Review of proposed addition to Anchor Christian Church located at 375 Beaver Road. Chili, N.Y. 14624

The Chair recognized Mr. Brent Mackie and Mr. Douglas Klotzbach and invited them to present the redesign.

Mr. Klotzbach presented the design and explained the changes incorporated. These included a change to the roof slope, matching the existing brick materials, a reduction in the mass of the glass block features, vinyl siding and brick wainscot. Mr. Latragna required that all the fascia trim would match. Mr. Emens confirmed that the eaves are 3 different heights and that brick is used as wainscot at the entrance. No other brick is used on the back of the building.. Mr. Ignatowski required that all exposed foundations and piers be finished with stucco.

The minutes from the September 24th 2014 meeting were moved for acceptance by Mr. Latragna and seconded by Mr. DiVito. The minutes were approved unanimously.

Mr. DiVito will represent the committee at the December 9th, 2014 Planning Board meeting.
