

CHILI ARCHITECTURAL ADVISORY COMMITTEE
July 14, 2015

A meeting of the Chili Architectural Advisory Committee was held on July 14, 2015 at the Chili Town Hall, 3333 Chili Avenue, Rochester, New York 14624 at 6:00 p.m. The meeting was called to order by Chairperson James Ignatowski.

PRESENT: Robert Latragna, Paul Wanzenried and Chairman James Ignatowski.

Chairperson James Ignatowski declared this to be a legally constituted meeting of the Chili Architectural Advisory Committee. He explained the meeting's procedures and introduced the Committee and front table. He announced the fire safety exits.

1. Review of proposed signage for Union Scrap Processing located at 3484 South Union Street, North Chili, NY 14514.

John Simmons was present to represent the application.

MR. SIMMONS: Thank you. Mr. Chairman, you probably remember I was here last month and after going back and consulting with the Sign Committee, after having the design approved last month, we decided to make some changes.

The issue that we have is the sign is going to set back approximately 130 feet from the main road and setting back that far, we really need to introduce some colors that are going to jump out. We are thinking red and blue.

When I was at the meeting here last month, we were talking black, white and gray. We just feel it's not going to cut it. The other thing we did, we increased the sign just a bit from 13 1/2 square foot to 15, and I'm hoping the Sign Committee will approve the redesign.

JAMES IGNATOWSKI: Any questions?

PAUL WANZENRIED: No.

JAMES IGNATOWSKI: You mean -- by "Sign Committee," you mean your committee from the business or --

MR. SIMMONS: This Committee here. I said, "Sign Committee."

I meant Architectural Advisory. I apologize.

JAMES IGNATOWSKI: Do you think it should be labeled on the prints what the exact colors are or it is self-explanational?

PAUL WANZENRIED: To me, I would believe it is self-explanatory, but if you want -- you want him to maintain that "Union" is in red and "Scrap Processing, Inc." is in blue, I would support that.

JAMES IGNATOWSKI: I -- my only question or my only recommendation would be that you just have your person design it and just label the colors. So, you know, whoever reviews the signage in terms of in the Building Department, it is just self-explanational or evident what colors you are picking out.

MR. SIMMONS: Specifically stating it is -- okay. I got you. Okay. Understood.

PAUL WANZENRIED: Other than that, I have no other questions or concerns.

ROBERT LATRAGNA: I find the new design to be superior to the old design. I have no objections.

MR. SIMMONS: Okay.

PAUL WANZENRIED: That's it, sir.

MR. SIMMONS: Thank you very much. I appreciate your time.

JAMES IGNATOWSKI: Next concern is we need to approve the minutes.

Robert Latragna made a motion to approve the 6/9/15 Architectural Advisory Committee minutes, and Paul Wanzenried seconded the motion. The vote on the motion to approve was 2 yes with 1 abstention (Robert Latragna).

The meeting was adjourned at 6:05 p.m.
