Correspondence – Bonnie asked who would be attending the Supervisor's Christmas Luncheon, everyone had already responded to Dawn. Christmas Luncheon will be held on Thursday, December 16th from 12 noon until 2:00pm. All staff and board members are invited to attend.

Bonnie explained they have spoken with Harold Ford an older resident of the town. Bonnie and Peter interviewed Harold on Tuesday, October 26th. This was very interesting and was taped and will be on file, and put on the Town's web site. During this interview, Bonnie and Peter learned a lot about Harold Ford growing up in Chili and Harold was in a George Raft movie.

Other suggestions for some interviews of older citizens of Chili were Bill Crow, Lorraine Drago, Ethel Miller and Tom Krenzer. Bill Crow has been scheduled to be interviewed. Also, suggested was Rona Pearce.

Some interesting information was given to Bonnie recently from the Chili Public Library. The staff was doing some cleaning out and found a family tree on paper. This was Joseph Morgan family. No one is sure where or who created this, but will be kept on file in the Historian's office. Peter suggested it may have come from Churchville-Chili or Gates-Chili Schools as a few years ago some of the classes did projects on History of Chili and surrounding towns.

2011 Meeting Dates – Bonnie discussed the meeting dates for 2011 and noting a conflict in October. The Tuesday, October 11th meeting is Columbus Day and the Town offices are closed on this day. Letter of Intent to Karlene VanDeusen – Nancy presented a draft of a letter to Karlene to let her know we would like to have her do our cover for the Barns Booklet at a fee of \$125. Nancy will send the letter to Karlene. A few changes were suggested and will be corrected.

Guest Carol Thoms gave the Board a power point on explanation of her barn. She has stated there are some ghost stories about her barn. She also has recently had it painted and a new roof put on the barn. It looks very nice. This is one of the barns we are considering for the cover of our barn book.

We ended the meeting with viewing the remaining barns and Linda kept track of the barns we are considering and we will be discussing these at a future meeting and getting stories and more pictures of some of these barns for the book. Thank you to Linda for doing this for us.

Motion was made by Peter and seconded by Linda Hamilton to adjourn. Meeting adjourned 9:00pm

Next meeting will be held Monday, December 13th in the Town Hall meeting room. We will have a small Christmas celebration. Pat agreed to get some Christmas Cards for us to sign to send out to the homes in preservation and the home owners of our Cobblestone homes.
