Summary of Approved Minutes

Minutes from the June 2011 Meeting were not approved due to insufficient members for a quorum

GUESTS:

OLD BUSINESS and WORK COMPLETED:

22 Rio Grande Dr. The town is aware of the problem, The solution to the problem will require all of the property owners to agree to allow work to be done. Several committee members have visited the site. The fence separating the property is illegal, and the shed is to close to the property line. Brian feels that the solution will involve excavation and installation of a 6 "perforated pipe leading to a 12" by 12" catch basin.

932 Paul Rd. Brian has looked at the site, and feels that the problem may need to be addressed in conjunction with the paving work scheduled on Paul Rd. Water drains south along the backyards of several homes, and then follows Paul Rd. in a westerly direction.

Wheat Hill: The Town cleaned along the edge of the wetland where cattails had clogged the inlet and outlet. Water is flowing better now.

310 Chestnut Ridge Rd. : West of Chili-Coldwater Rd. Town cleaned out pond, removed dead trees and debris and reshaped pond.

6,8,10,12 Cutter Dr.: Work is progressing, existing pipe is very deep, some of the catch basins are made of concrete. After work is completed, will address problem on Red Bud. Need to bring Pond there up to code.

14,16,18,22,24, Wills Rd.: On the list of work to be started, weather permitting.

Creekview: Work completed

9, 11, 13 Matlyn Dr.: Work to begin as soon as weather permits.

38 Blue Ridge Trail: Work completed

Park Place including 18 Tyndale Way: Cleaning up a number of Catch Basins in the sub-division.

Black Cedar: Work completed

128 Loyalist: Work completed

52 Wilellen: The Town has not heard back from the homeowner.
