Summary of Approved Minutes
Town of Chili Drainage Committee

October 1, 2013

Matthew Sinacola, Chairperson called the meeting to order at 7:05 p.m.

The meeting was held at the New Town Highway Garage Facility at 200 Beaver Rd.

MEMBERS PRESENT:

MEMBERS ABSENT: Ron De George, and Jarod Hirt

MINUTES:

The September 2013 Meeting minutes was reviewed, several corrections were addressed, and then minutes were approved unanimously.

GUESTS:

Vlade and Amy Kordavitch: 3 Oaktwist Ln.: The homeowners are concerned about a long standing problem with water accumulating in the back of their yard. They pointed out that the problem was not present 9 years ago, when they first moved to 3 Oaktwist Lane. They are

convinced that the problem surfaced a number of years ago, when the neighbors on either side of them built swimming pools. After a heavy rain episode, they indicated that the water can reach a depth of 1 to 2 feet in the vicinity of the Town drainage easement. Brian and several of the committee members asked a number of questions regarding the problem with the grading in the area. Brian pointed out to the homeowners that the DPW is aware of the problem, from prior years back. **(Oct 2011)** Brian will follow up with the Committee at our next meeting to discuss options.

Joseph Bulleus and Joshua Scarpino: Students from Churchville Chili High School who were auditing the meeting for a class project.

OLD BUSINESS and WORK COMPLETED:

NEW BUSINESS:

3358 Chili Ave: Homeowner is concerned about the backyard drain that is not functioning well. He would like the DPW to take a look, to see if it may be plugged up.

REVIEW:

Robert Wesleyan College: New Science and Nursing Building

Robert Wesleyan College: New Parking Lot adjoining the Main Campus on the west side of the college. The College is planning to combine (5 Lots), **15,17,21,23,** and **25 Orchard St.** The Committee briefly discussed concerns that were raised about the drainage flow from the parking lot. Brian pointed out that the drainage flow ultimately empties into a drain that flows back to Orchard St. and not to the neighbor's yards that border the lots to the west.

Hoagies and Deli Pizza: 1615 Scottsville Rd.: Internal use issues, not relevant to the Drainage Committee
