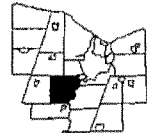

APPROVED MINUTES

Minutes of the 3/5/09 Meeting

Present: B. Grover/ Chairman, C. Schwab/Vice Chairman & Sect'y, T. Schreck, M. Kretser, G. Barnett

Liaison: Sheriff Capt. D. Bergmann, MCDOT Brent Penwarden, Mary Sperr

Meeting called to order by Chairman Brad Grover at 7:00P.M.
Minutes of the February meeting were approved.

OLD BUSINESS 7/6/06

- Item # 4 Traffic is backing up on Rt. 259 past Rt. 490 exit from Chili Ave. The intersection continues to be a hazard. What is the schedule for the permanent fix to the problem? **State to widen road for 2 lanes for southbound traffic, one lane for left turns (no signal upgrade). The MCSO with conjunction with the NYSDOT recognize that using the shoulder of the road to pass a vehicle turning left is within the law and the current traffic flow. State has scheduled to start work on intersection on 06/09.**

OLD BUSINESS 10/4/07

- Item # 2 Barb Denigris of 254 Archer Rd representing the residents are concerned about safety as current speeds are in excess of the 30mph. **Committee will continue to monitor, and the towns' temporary signs were used. The Monroe County Sheriff has increased patrols. D. Lindsay has installed "Slow Down" marker signs on the sign post. Signs will be repositioned once snow melts.**

OLD BUSINESS 2/7/08

- Item # 3 Railroad tracks on Paul Rd. near Beaham Rd. are very rough. **Full repair to done the summer of 2009**

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OLD BUSINESS 8/7/08

Item # 3 Request for speed bumps on Evergreen. **D. Lindsay to install "Slow Down" marker signs on the sign post, weather permitting.**

FYI At the intersection of Morgan Rd and Union St. the bushes are growing out to the road. The bushes need to be trimmed. **D. Lindsay has contacted the home owner about trimming the bushes. Brent Penwarden will write a letter and/or have bushes trimmed.**

OLD BUSINESS 9/4/08

Item # 1 Crosswalk over the railroad tracks on Old Scottsville road are worn off. **D. Lindsay will install "Thermal Strips" for new crosswalk markings when the temperature reaches above 40 degrees.**

OLD BUSINESS 10/2/08

Item # 1 Median at entrance into Wegmans from Paul Rd. needs to be painted to designate the entrance and exit. **D. Lindsay checked on status with Target and is on track for late March.**

Item # 3 Speeding on Emerald Point Rd. **Committee to investigate. Temporary sign to be put up in the Spring.**

OLD BUSINESS 11/6/08

Item # 4 G. Barnett express concern about some low hanging wires and the poles that the wires are attached to, at the location of the proposed Microtel Hotel. The poles need some protection around them to prevent them from being hit as well as additional poles to hold the wires higher for truck traffic. **F. Trott has referred it to the building department.**

OLD BUSINESS 1/8/09

Item # 1 At intersection of King Rd. and Union St. there is a need for left turn lane off Union St. and for a right lane for thru traffic. **D. Lindsay e-mailed state. Further concern regarding pole on Union directly across from King Rd.**

OLD BUSINESS 2/5/09

Item # 1 S. Ginovsky of Hubbard Drive expressed concern regarding snow ordinance. He has made calls to Dept. of Highway and 911 regarding cars not obeying ordinance but feels there is a lack of enforcement. **D. Lindsay explained policy at Dept. of Highway is to leave two letters on windshield of car if additional enforcement is needed after that, a call is placed to 911. Committee encouraged him to call Dept of Highway and/or 911 when observing it.**

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- Item # 2 Concern for sinking road on Lexington Parkway as well as pothole of corner of Lexington and Newport. **D. Lindsay to investigate. Has been reported one hole has been repaired.**
- Item # 3 Committee reviewed draft of McDonald's plans. **Committee expressed concerns regarding two way lane in front of building and will the driveways be one way. Further concern for emergency exist for first drive-thru lane, and will there be a walkway put in back.**

NEW BUSINESS 3/5/09

- Item # 1 Westside Drive between the two Chili Coldwater Roads, the road is buckling. **Committee to investigate.**
- Item #2 902 Chili Coldwater Road. There is a need for more cold patch to be put down. **Committee to investigate.**
- Item #3 FYI- Bowen Rd will be used as a detour on Stottle Road when work on the 2 bridges starts.
- Item #4 FYI-Cheveron's on Chili Ave bridge over Black Creek have lost their reflection. **Committee to investigate.**

No further business discussed. Meeting adjourned at 7:31 PM
