

**The Chili Community Center** consists of a few former classroom spaces and a small gymnasium. The main offices for our Recreation Department are located on the second level in one of the former classrooms. The classrooms are used for a variety of small gatherings, meetings & programs. The gymnasium is the largest of the open space areas in the facility. Most community events and programs cannot be held in this facility due to space/occupancy restrictions. The more popular community events are either moved to the Senior Center or offsite to a larger facility.
