Who can vote and what should we expect?

Who can vote?

A person must be a citizen of the United States, at least 18 years old, and a resident of the Town of Chili for a minimum of 30 days prior to the vote. To be a resident, a person must be physically present with the intent to remain for a time and could register as a voter if they have not already done so.

What should I expect when I come to vote?

- You should bring a valid picture ID. Proceed to the table that matches the first letter of your last name for check in.
- If you are a registered voter in Chili and your ID matches the voter registration book, you will be able to vote on the machine.
- If you are not a Chili registered voter, but have a valid ID that shows a Chili address, you will need to sign an oath that you are a qualified Chili voter and will cast your vote on a machine.
- If you are in the voter registration book but lack a valid ID with a Chili address, or if you are not in the voter registration book and do not have a valid ID with a Chili address, you will vote via a paper affidavit after signing an oath attesting that you are a qualified Chili voter.
