GUESTS:

Dave Francis, 12 Provence Dr.: Homeowner described a drainage Issue in his backyard, indicates that a swale has narrowed over the past few years, causing water to settle. As a result. It takes a great deal of time to drain off. Brian indicated that he will verify whether there is an easement to access the site, and will take a look and report back to the Committee at the next meeting.

Todd and Karen Cunningham, 29 Woodside Dr.: Homeowners describe a Drainage issue where water is filling a 6' x 6' catch basin (Dry well) during extended rain events. The water then drains back into the house. The Homeowners added that this problem is affecting a number of the houses in the area. Brian suggested that the Neighbors talk among themselves to see if they can agree to remove some of the fencing to allow for equipment to be brought to the location. He further suggested that a French drain may be a potential solution to the problem.
