**Todd Cunningham, 29 Woodside Dr.:** Homeowner has returned to get an update on the status. Brian indicated that the town would agree to do the work, contingent of all the neighbors agreeing to remove their fences. Mr. Cunningham indicated that all the neighbors had agreed. Brian will schedule the work when things dry out a bit, after brush and leaves are picked up.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

**12 Provence Dr.;** Brian indicated that there is a large Wetland south of Provence Dr., that slowly drains into a creek. After conducting a site visit, he determined that the catch basin was full, the creek is full, and the entire drainage system was full as well. Unfortunately, because of the water table, there is little that can be done, short of allowing the system to drain off naturally with drier weather.
