

Town of Chili Conservation Board Meeting Approved Minutes for Nov. 4, 2019.

The Chili Conservation Board meeting was called to order at 7:05 p.m. on November 4, 2019 at the Chili Town Offices, 3333 Chili Avenue, Rochester, New York 14624.

Present: Carolyn DeHority, Pat Tindale, Richard Schickler (Vice-Chair), Larry Lazenby (Chair), William Steimer, and Jill Fornarola.

Minutes: Carolyn DeHority made the motion to approve the October 7, 2019 meeting minutes seconded by William Steimer. The Conservation Board unanimously approved.

- At our 12/2/20 meeting, Bill Steimer made the motion that we remove and avoid using the name Round Up in our minutes. It should state: Avoid using pesticides and use instead alternatives such as Epson Salts and vinegar. Pesticides should be used only when necessary and as a last resort.
After a very informative discussion period, the motion was seconded by Ilze and the vote was unanimous.

No Liaison Report: Jordon Brown was absent.

Monroe County Environmental Management Council Report: Richard Schickler advised the Conservation Board that the last meeting by the EMC was about bees and different species of bees. A detailed discussion specifically about the conditions that bee colonies need to survive and thrive and what type of garden plants are best for them. Avoid using pesticides such as the product called Round Up and a better alternative to kill weeds on your property is to use a mixture of Epson salt and vinegar.

INFORMAL:

1. Application of TUGI, LLC, owner; 1233 Lehigh Station Road, Henrietta, New York 14467 for final site plan approval to erect a 30,000 sq. ft. industrial building at property located at 1891 Scottsville Road in L.I. & FPO zone.

Upon inspection from Chair Larry Lazenby, that a civil engineer designed the proper storm water management for the project, the prints can be stamped, signed and approved by him. Motion to Approve: Bill Steimer made the motion seconded by Pat Tindale. Passed with unanimous approval.
