**OLD BUSINESS:**

**CHILI FIRST PROJECT:** We read the list from October's meeting. Bonnie asked us to select three which we would prioritize. We agreed that Bucksbee Corner should be recognized as the location of Chili's first business meeting.

**OUR FIRST 3 SELECTIONS PRIORITIZED:**

Hamlet of Clifton,  
Bucksbee Corner (named after a family which owned a seed company. The meeting was in Colemans Inn (North West Corner of Union and Chili)—first business meeting, stone bridges. Bonnie suggested a booklet to recognize our firsts.

**NEXT STEPS:** Create a proposal to give Supervisor Dunning— John recommended a mock up of what the signage would look like at Bucksbee Corner. Bonnie will speak to David Dunning and/or Dave Lindsay to discuss the possibility of placing a sign and who to contact for allowance. Peter said the cost of a poll with a sign is \$1800. Standardize signs. (theme on the signs, Town of Chili. Relief of the structure may be expensive. John suggested Peter share verbiage of the sign on his property at our next meeting. Bonnie will report on her progress with David. Phil suggested an interactive map on the town website. Phil suggested possibly imbed something called "Chili's Firsts" in the website.

Peter would like to work on the Clifton Firsts. He will ask citizens for help with the history of Clifton. Clifton Fire Department is a possible place for a sign. Funding? Peter will draft signage and ask citizens for suggestions. Historic message on the sign?

James Valerio suggested contacting Cynthia Houk to see if there is grant money to help with Hamlet of Clifton. Peter will contact her to see if there are funds available. He will let David Dunning know about contacting Cynthia Houk.

**Further contact with the Dillenbecks who own the cobblestone home on Stuart Rd.**

Phil suggested that we start again with an updated certificate of merit.
