OLD BUSINESS

Date	Issue/Concern	Discussion/Actions Taken
Aug 4, 2022 Item #1	Town citizens informed the committee that they have a concern with the intersection of Beaver Rd./Beaver Rd. Ext, and Flinton Run.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • There have been multiple accidents at the intersection of Beaver Rd./Beaver Rd. Ext, and Finton Run. This is one of the newer town intersections that involves the Rose Hill Estates development. The concerned citizens are aware that the road is a state road, and any engineering or installation of stop lights is completely at the discretion of the NYSDOT. After discussion, the committee will investigate improvements for this intersection specific to signage and sight lines. The committee will make a recommendation to the Town Highway department for any needed actions. • [Sept 1] Discussion and no additional action. • [Oct. 6] Town is working on street signage and foliage trimming. • [Nov 6] Town will reach out to NYSDOT to confirm signage and request placement where needed. • [Dec 1] Awaiting response from NYSDOT. • [Jan 5] No additional information • [Feb 2] Awaiting response from NYSDOT. • [Mar 2] Awaiting response from NYSDOT. • [Apr 6] NYSDOT responded and plan to review the section for proper sign placement. • [May 4] NYSDOT foliage trimming (town with revisit later in the season), review of speed limit sign placements and those were deemed appropriate, committee will return to NYSDOT regarding a 4-way intersection + sign placement. • [Aug 3] Town will confirm with NYSDOT on the need for a four-way intersection sign. • [Sept 7] No word from NYSDOT
Dec 1, 2022 Issue #1	Committee member Tom Schreck reports that the streetlight on Union St. just south of Rt. 33A (Chili Ave.) is out and needs to be replaced.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The highway department needs to be informed and committee member Schreck was asked to contact the highway department to ensure that the streetlight is fixed. • [Jan 5] Town has reported to RGE. • [Feb 2] Awaiting RGE to complete work.

April 6, 2023	A concerned citizen raised awareness of parking along Buffalo Rd. (Rt. 33) and Orchard St. The issue mainly is present during peak business hours of the nearby ice cream shop and that patrons are parking their vehicles illegally or in unsafe manners	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The committee will review and verify the concern later in the season when the ice cream shop is open and during peak times. • [May 4] Committee will refer any discovered issues with code enforcement. • [Aug 3] Several committee members have gone by business to assess parking situation and no issues were observed. • [Sept 7] Closed

NEW BUSINESS


Date	Issue/Concern	Discussion/Actions Taken
Sept. 7, 2023 Item #1	Concerned citizens approached the committee and expressed their concern with excessive speed on Gateway Rd.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • After discussions, it was decided that the area will be included for driver feedback signs; weather permitting and if not be on the rotation for Spring 2024. Additional discussion around the possibility of adding a stop sign – it was explained the process of having a stop sign added. Committee also will look to inform MCSO on adding the neighborhood for special attention.
Sept. 7, 2023 Item #2	Several committee members received complaints about the “non-right turn only lane” on Union St and Fulham Pl. and that this extra lane is confusing for drivers heading southbound.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Discussion was made about why this lane was stripped/painted and many agreed that it is awkward and easily confusing. There is a potential danger/safety in that unknowing drivers assume it is the right turn into Black Creek Park who then have to quickly move back over into the previous lane. It is suggested that the county look at possible restriping this lane to reduce or eliminate the confusion of the lane being a right turn only.
